Stephens Park – appreciate the riding so far

Illiniwek – trails are close- hope to get period of 4 days w/o rain and to be able to open. Need some spring maintenance, leaf blowing, etc. Will post trail days in next week or so.

Dorrance – finished the bridge and first loop. Still too wet to ride. A few more trail days to get things buttoned/cleaned up. Hopefully, after Abermination will have official grand opening out there – invite all of Forc, Port Byron, River Action, etc. Tentatively May 7^{th} (Sunday – late morning). Trail will be $3 \frac{1}{2}$ - 4 miles when done.

Westbrook – coming to end of 203 – finish once get dry weather and starting last loop of 204 then. Should be $6 \frac{1}{2}$ - 7 miles when complete.

Scott County – new ranger; doing some maintenance on areas of erosion.

Geneseo – Rode last night – was wet, but not muddy; probably too wet today. Almost 3 miles of trail. In contact with city administrator; moving parking area off of 82 and moving to the entrance where the city currently burns (where sand pile is). City wants to redo the gate and the pedestrian access. Schnauffer wants input on a kiosk – Drew has drawings. Thinks the animals are going. He and Bobby talking about doing another ride to Geneseo and hitting the breweries; potentially later in May. **Sunderbruch** – Jubilee is closed for the foreseeable future; bridge is falling apart – been deconstructed. Probably getting started on repairs after the Abermination. May be putting up some inexpensive signs at trail heads to remind people about when trails are closed, they are closed for everyone.
